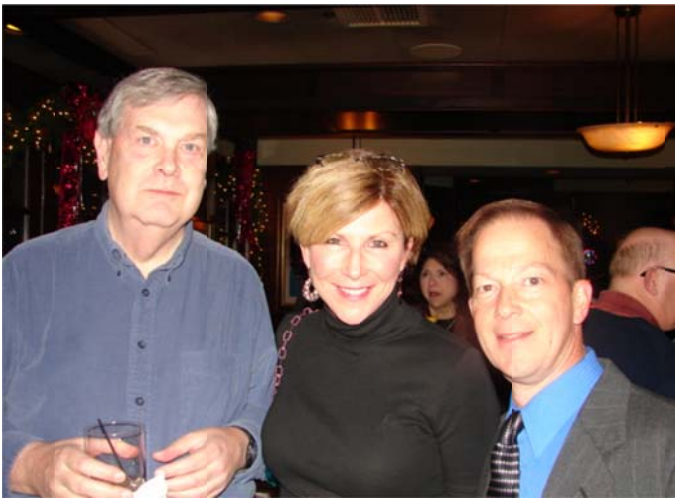
ST. LOUIS OPTOMETRY LOSES A FRIEND
